TUG HARBOUR WORKS

Further to December's Community Report, John Holland Pty Ltd is mobilising to the tug harbour laydown area to commence the DBCT offshore works contract, which includes construction of a 4th berth and widening of the offshore jetty to allow for a 3rd outloading conveyor.

For approximately the next 18 months, the tug harbour will be used to transport workers and equipment to the offshore project, as has been the case with previous expansions.

We are very aware of the importance of the tug harbour to the community, and will strive to limit impact on boat ramp access as much as possible. To ensure your safety during this time, we have undertaken to do the following immediate work to improve the car parking area:

- Laser-level and grade the car park and providing fill material as required
- Improve the drainage
- Where possible, line-mark the car park to make vehicle parking more efficient
- Upgrade the road surface on the access road from the causeway to the car park
- Grade the shoulder of the causeway road to provide additional safe parking in peak times
- Install appropriate safety signage in the parking areas.

In addition, because the use of the tug harbour car park will see sustained activity outside the area of the expansion project lease, we intend to further extend our usual community commitment. We are currently progressing negotiations with various agencies and authorities, with the objective to implement a boat ramp car park improvement project at the completion of the DBCT offshore project. Further details will be provided as they become available.

The car park improvement project is BBI (DBCT)'s contribution to enhancing community amenity and safety at the boat ramp and parking area.
