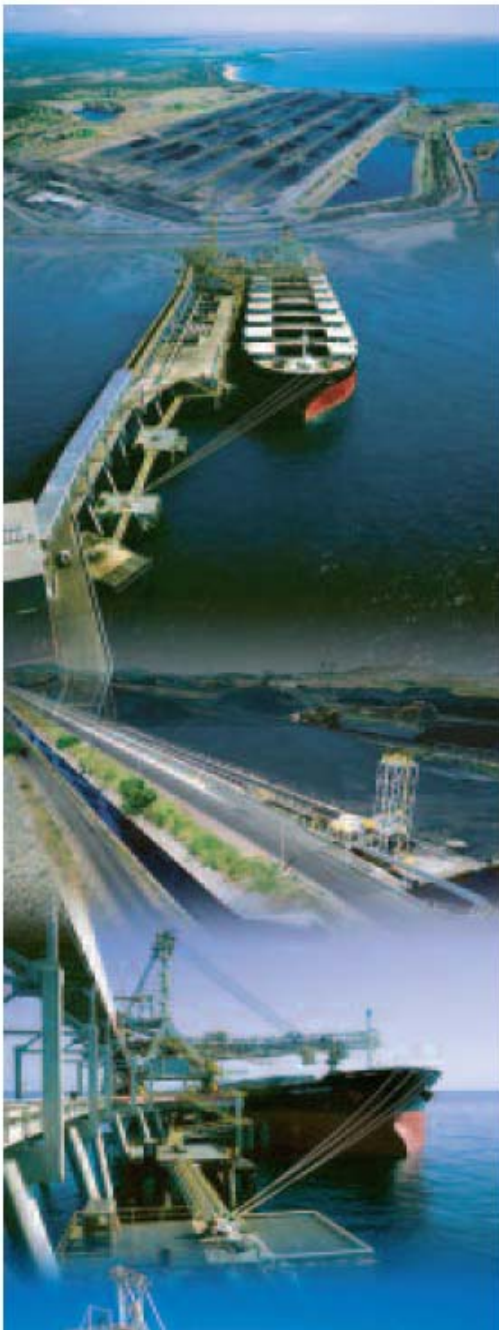

NEW JETTY WORK TO COMMENCE AT DBCT



As part of the DBCT 7X Project, construction of a new out loading jetty and Berth 4 wharf will commence soon.

The new jetty will be constructed from the shore on the south of the existing jetty, and will proceed east. Work will commence next week and will continue for approximately 12 – 14 months.

Work on the new Berth 4 wharf will commence in June and will be constructed from the existing structure, heading north.

It is anticipated nearby residents may hear some distant noise generated by the pile driving depending on the wind direction. However, noise will reduce as the jetty work moves offshore.

Piling works will occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm Monday to Saturday. However, on the rare occasions that pile driving takes longer than expected, driving may continue after 6:30pm as piles cannot be left partially driven.

The team will ensure that such occurrences are kept to a minimum.
