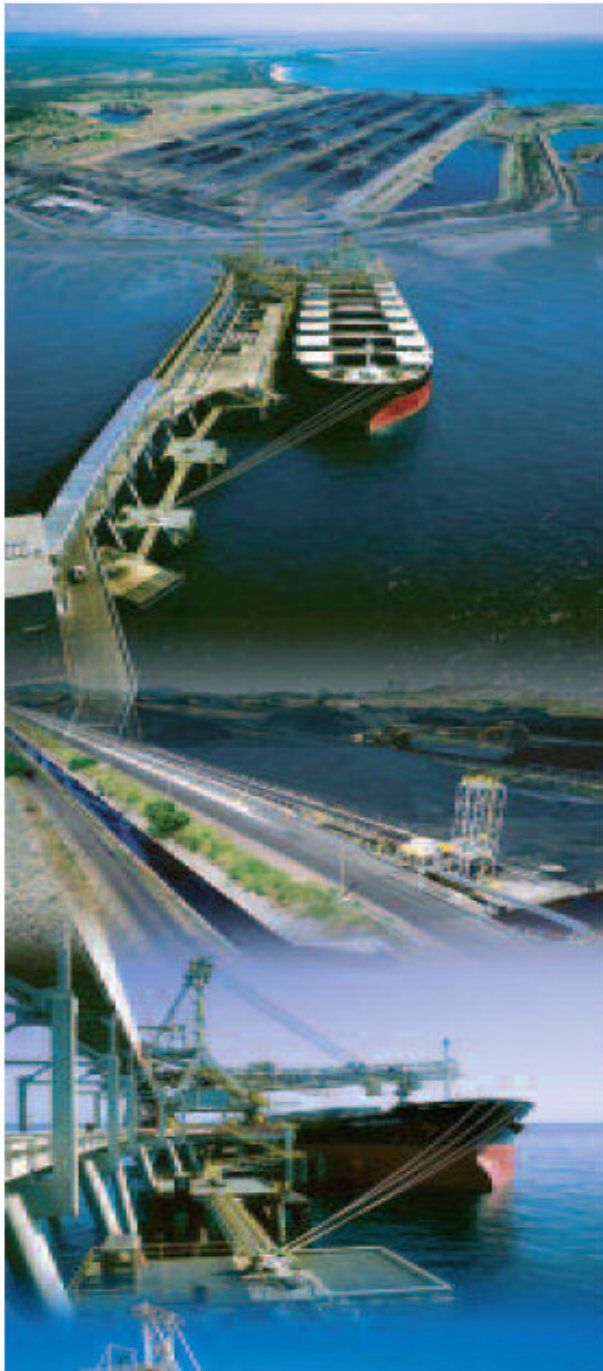


DBCT 7X EXPANSION MARINE WORKS – COMMUNITY NOTICE TO BOAT OPERATORS

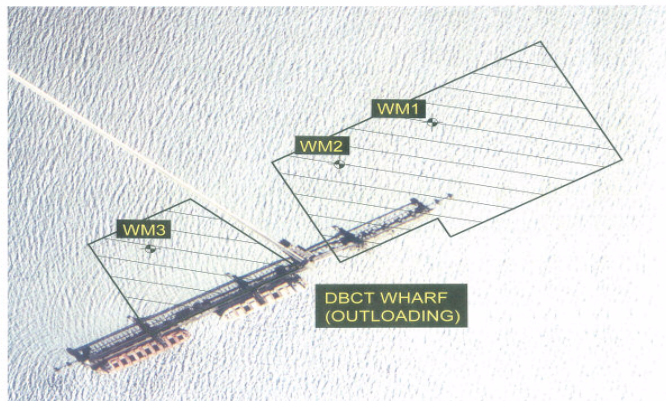
As part of the DBCT 7X Offshore Expansion works, the John Holland Group has recently installed a number of mooring buoys in both the Hay Point Tug Harbour area near the public boat ramp and offshore on the western side of the DBCT berths.

The buoys have been placed to allow new piles for the 350M extension of the northern berth to be moored in readiness for pile driving, and to provide mooring for John Holland's support craft. All mooring buoys and the moored piles are lit with approved flashing lights at night.

The drawings below give the general area of where mooring anchors have now been laid. The mooring buoys will move in the general area above their anchor position, depending on wind and tide conditions.



In addition to remaining outside the DOTARS imposed 50 metre security zone that surrounds the entire offshore facility, boat operators should also stay outside the shaded or hatched areas shown on the photos while marine activities are underway. Offshore marine works are not expected to be completed before Nov 2008.
